Context

- Up to 10% of patients are affected by gaps in care and safety across Europe
- Workforce shortages, aging populations, and poor conditions hinder care delivery
- Burnout and long hours increase error risk
- **Aim:** To present workforce-driven strategies to improve QoC through better workforce conditions.
